6) Prejudice on gender, ethnics and sexual orientation, Fondazione Cariplo.2012-2014

The project aims at 'mapping' the different forms in which prejudice and stereotypes shape and are articulated in contemporary societies and at investigating their presence/absence. The empirical part of the research is based on a survey conducted among students of the University of Milan. The goal is that of building a "prejudice index" which includes indicators related to gender, sexual orientation and ethnicity.

7) Collective representation and political participation of women migrants: the Italian case in a comparative perspective, Fondazione Cariplo, 2010-2012

The research focuses on the conditions of migrant workers starting from the relationship between immigration, representation, participation and access to social benefit. The analysis develops from the consideration of immigrant workers exclusion from representation, from social benefits, and from a full access to political rights. Such exclusion occurs in spite of their active role on the labour market and their participation to the financing of welfare systems. It results to be even more relevant in the case of migrant women who are often employed within informal economy.

8) Gender and Citizenship I and II (2004-2005 and 2007-2009), Fondazione Cariplo

The general goals of these projects are: encouraging the introduction of gender studies and the use of a gender perspective in existing fields of research and teaching areas; carrying on research on educational choices and horizontal segregation; enhancing accessibility; favoring greater integration and more active interactions between universities, institutions and citizens with regard to gender-related policies, research dissemination, public initiatives.
